Referees – you have the professional indemnity insurance cover:

If and only if, your Boxing Tas Inc membership is up to date, referees are covered by a Professional Indemnity and Public Liability insurance policy. The policy covers qualified officials whilst acting in their judge or referee capacity, against claim arising from negligent acts, errors or omission whenever or wherever committed or alleged to have been committed in connection with the sport provided the incident and any claim occur during the insured period. If you renew your membership prior to the 1st of February each year your insurance cover will continue without interruption, otherwise you will have a gap in cover.

Ringside Officials – Hepatitis B vaccination strongly recommended

Hepatitis B is one of several blood borne diseases that can cause serious illness. A tiny drip of blood containing the Hepatitis B virus can transmit the virus to others via cuts, or via contact with membranes such as the eye. This disease can be prevented by vaccination. Everyone is encouraged to have a Hepatitis B vaccination, but ringside officials such as referees, judges, timekeepers and gloving stewards in particular are strongly advised to do so. Your doctor can advise you on the cost of the vaccine.
